We reviewed the summary and discussed that we need to differentiate better between "side paths" and "off road paths". We do need to still review further road where "road diets" should be considered.

Need to follow-up on how to get all of Springfield's marked bike lanes/paths on Google maps and PVPC list, etc. There is a new MassDOT mapping portal that may help with this.,

II. 2022 Paving List (attached)

We discussed which roads should improve pedestrian and bicycle accommodation when being repaved. Deb will review Goodwin Street (Page Blvd to Pinevale) and Liberty Street (Chicopee line to Armory); Betsy will review Birchland Ave (Wilbraham to North) and White Street (Belmont to E. Longmeadow line) and Rifle Street (Allen to Hancock); Jim will review Sumner Ave. (Daytona to Converse) and Sumner Ave. (Longhill to Ft. Pleasant – does this connect to X Project?)

Need others to contact "311" and indicate that Dwight Road from Tiffany to Franconia Golf Course is in desperate need of repaying!

Trial of road narrowing for State Street. Narrowing needs to start closer to Spring/School to help Elliot St. crossing, More needed to slow cars.
